CHAPTER Pr20

**An Act to revive
Port Elgin Sportsmen's Club**

Assented to June 25th, 1992

Preamble

Murray Wolfe has applied for special legislation to revive Port Elgin Sportsmen's Club. The applicant represents that he was a member of the corporation at the time of its dissolution. The Minister of Consumer and Commercial Relations dissolved the corporation on the 8th day of September, 1982 for default in complying with the *Corporations Information Act*. The applicant represents that he did not receive notice of the default, that he was not aware of the dissolution of the corporation until more than five years after it had occurred and that activity has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Port Elgin Sportsmen's Club is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved. Corporation revived

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commencement

3. The short title of this Act is the *Port Elgin Sportsmen's Club Act, 1992*. Short title
