CHAPTER 67

An Act to amend The Pounds Act

Assented to July 8th, 1975

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 3 of *The Pounds Act*, being chapter 353 of the s.3, Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is repealed.
- 2. Sections 4 and 5 of the said Act are repealed and the following ss. 4, 5, substituted therefor:
 - 4. No cattle, goat, horse, sheep or swine shall be allowed Animals not to run at large in any part of a provisional judicial district at large not included in an organized municipality.
 - 5. The owner of any cattle, goat, horse, sheep or swine Owner of running at large contrary to section 4 is liable in damages Isable for for all injuries committed by such animal or animals, and fine also is guilty of an offence and on summary conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$300.
- 3. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commencement
- 4. This Act may be cited as The Pounds Amendment Act, 1975. Short little
