Please request a meeting with the Sudanese authorities with regard to Mr. Abdelrazik (CAMANT 03-KHRTM-1060383) in order to register the following points:

 Canada has examined the evidence available and, at this time, there are no grounds for bringing charges against Mr. Abdelrazik in Canada.

- If he were released would he be free to travel in and leave Sudan, or would he be required to stay in regular contact with Sudanese authorities in a specific location?
- If he is released, we will provide him with the normal consular services available to Canadians released from custody overseas.

You should also request another consular visit at the same meeting.
