ABDELRAZIK, Abousfian v. Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Re: Trade - Federal Court File No.: T-727-08

I have been authorized by the Attorney General of Canada to disclose the fact that a notice pursuant to section 38.01 of the Canada Evidence Act has been served in respect of the documents requested by you in your Direction to Attend for Sean Robertson. Accordingly, we are prohibited from releasing any documents included within the scope of the notice and will not be providing any documents at the cross examination of Mr. Robertson scheduled for tomorrow.

We acknowledge receipt of your two Amended Directions to Attend. At the case management conference of September 18, 2008 Mr. Hameed advised the Court that he was no longer seeking documents as set out at parapgraphs 3, 4, 7, 9, 11, 12 and 13 and my clients have conducted their search for documents based on those representations. Your Amended Directions do not reflect the position on paragraph 9 as expressed by Mr. Hameed. In any event, it is our position that the documents requested for paragraphs 9 and 10 are not relevant to the matters at issue in this Application and we will not be producing those documents.
