CHAPTER 33

**An Act to amend the
Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act**

Assented to June 9th, 1983

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Section 32 of the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Act*, being chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1980, is repealed and the following substituted therefor: s. 32,
re-enacted

32.—(1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3), where a boiler, pressure vessel or plant is found to be in an unsafe condition, no person shall make any major repairs thereto until he has notified an inspector of the nature and extent of such repairs and an inspector has concurred therewith, and the boiler, pressure vessel or plant shall not be put into operation or use until a further inspection by an inspector has been made and the chief inspector has issued a new certificate of inspection therefor. (2) Where a boiler, pressure vessel or plant referred to in subsection (1) is insured, the concurrence and inspection required under subsection (1) may be made by or through the insurer and the insurer may issue a new certificate of inspection therefor. Idem

(3) The chief inspector may exempt in writing the owner of a plant that is normally operated twenty-four hours a day for seven days a week from the requirements of subsection (1) where he is satisfied that the repairs will be carried out in a safe and proper manner and subject to such terms and conditions as are prescribed in the regulations or required by the chief inspector. 2. Section 36 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto the following subsection: s. 36,

(12) In this section, “employer” includes a trade association of persons or companies whose business includes welding. Interpre-

3. Section 42 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto the following clause:

- (t) prescribing terms to which exemptions made under section 32 of this Act are subject.

4. This Act comes into force on a day to be named by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor.

Short title

5. The short title of this Act is the *Boilers and Pressure Vessels Amendment Act, 1983*.
