CHAPTER 29

An Act to amend the Energy Act

Assented to June 20th, 1989

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1.—(1) Subsection 28 (1) of the Energy Act, being chapter 139 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1980, is amended by adding thereto the following clause:

(na) designating persons or classes of persons empowered to administer any code or standard adopted under subsection (2) and delegating to the designated persons or classes the authority to administer any code or standard adopted.

(2) Section 28 of the said Act is amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

(4) The Director may allow a variance from any code Variance by adopted under the regulations or any provision in the regulations where, in the Director's opinion, the variance would not detrimentally affect the safety of the appliance, pipeline or work.

(5) The Director may authorize the use of a new code or Use of new standard or changes to established codes or standards necessary to accommodate technological advances for a limited time and subject to any conditions specified.

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Commencement Assent.

3. The short title of this Act is the Energy Amendment Act, Short title 1989.
