## CHAPTER Pr49

## An Act to revive All-Wood Land Clearing Ltd.

*Assented to December 14, 1993*

## Preamble

Paul Adam has applied for special legislation to revive All-Wood Land Clearing Ltd. The applicant represents that he was a director and shareholder of the corporation when it was dissolved. The corporation was dissolved under the *Business Corporations Act, 1982* on May 17, 1988 for failure to comply with the *Corporations Tax Act*. The applicant represents that he did not receive the notice of default and that business has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assem-

bly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. All-Wood Land Clearing Ltd. is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.
