CHAPTER Pr26

An Act to revive Rideau Trail Association

Assented to June 25th, 1992

Preamble

Elizabeth M. McIver has applied for special legislation to revive Rideau Trail Association. The applicant represents that she is a director of the ongoing association carried on in the name of the corporation. The Minister of Consumer and Commercial Relations dissolved the corporation on the 17th day of September, 1979 for default in filing annual returns. The applicant represents that this default was inadvertent and that activities have been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assem-

bly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Rideau Trail Association is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.
