CANADA, 23-24 ELIZABETH II, CHAPTER 28

An act to increase the representation of the Northwest Territories in the House of Commons and to establish a commission to readjust the electoral boundaries of the Northwest Territories

[Assented to 13th March, 1975]

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Act may be cited as the Northwest Territories Rep- Short title resentation Act.

PART I

BRITISH NORTH AMERICA ACT

2. Subsection 51 (2) of the British North America Act, 1867, as enacted by the British North America Act, 1952, is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"(2) The Yukon Territory as bounded and described in the Yukon Territory and schedule to chapter Y-2 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, Northwest 1970, shall be entitled to one member, and the Northwest Territories Territories as bounded and described in section 2 of chapter N-22 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1970, shall be entitled to two members "

3. This Part may be cited as the British North America Act, Short title 1975, and the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1974-75 and this Part may be cited together as the British North America Acts, 1867 to 1975.
