CHAPTER Pr46

**An Act to revive
Fefferlaw Developments Limited**

Assented to December 10th, 1992

Preamble

Gail Freida Winemaker has applied for special legislation to revive Fefferlaw Developments Limited. The applicant represents that she was a director and holder of common shares of the corporation when it was dissolved. The Director appointed under the *Business Corporations Act* dissolved the corporation on the 9th day of March, 1987 for default in complying with the *Corporations Tax Act*. The applicant represents that this default was inadvertent, that she was not aware of the dissolution until more than five years after it had occurred and that business has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Fefferlaw Developments Limited is Corporation revived
revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

2. This Act comes into force on the day it Commence-
receives Royal Assent. ment

3. The short title of this Act is the Short title
Fefferlaw Developments Limited Act, 1992.
