CHAPTER Pr3

An Act respecting the the Town of Bothwell

Assented to March 31, 1994

Preamble

The Corporation of the Town of Bothwell, referred to in this Act as the Corporation, has applied for special legislation in respect of the matters set out in this Act.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

providing that the council of the Corporation shall be composed of a mayor, a reeve and three councillors to be elected by general vote.

(2) A by-law passed under subsection (1) or a by-law repealing it shall be passed not later than thirty days before the last day for posting notice of the offices for which persons may be nominated in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act*. Timing

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commencement

3. The short title of this Act is the *Town of Bothwell Act, 1994*. Short title

By-law
respecting
composition
of council

1. (1) Despite subsections 31 (3), (4) and (5) of the *Municipal Act*, the council of the Corporation may, without receiving the assent of the municipal electors, pass a by-law
