CHAPTER Pr21

**An Act to revive
The Hamilton and Region Arts Council**

Assented to June 23, 1994

Preamble

Charles Renaud has applied for special legislation to revive The Hamilton and Region Arts Council. The applicant represents that he is a director of the ongoing organization carried on in the name of the corporation. The corporation was dissolved under the *Corporations Act* on January 27, 1987 for default in complying with the *Corporations Information Act*. The applicant represents that this default was inadvertent, that the applicant was not aware of the dissolution of the corporation until more than five years after it had occurred and that activities have been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. The Hamilton and Region Arts Council is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.
