**An Act respecting the  
County of Essex and the  
Local Municipalities in it**

*Assented to June 23, 1994*

Title changed	<p><b>2.</b> (1) Despite the <i>Municipal Act</i>, the titles of “reeve” and “deputy reeve” on each local municipality in the County of Essex referred to in the Schedule are abolished.</p>	<p><b>5.</b> This Act does not affect the composition of county council nor does it amend the numerical composition of the local councils.</p>	Councils unaffected
Same	<p>(2) Despite the <i>Municipal Act</i>, the head of each local municipality referred to in the Schedule shall be called a mayor.</p>	<p><b>6.</b> (1) <b>This Act comes into force on December 1, 1994.</b></p> <p><b>(2) Despite subsection (1), the regular election to be held in 1994 under the <i>Municipal Elections Act</i> shall be conducted as if this Act were in force and a by-law may be passed under section 3 for that purpose.</b></p>	Commencement Next election
Deputy mayor	<p><b>3.</b> (1) A council of a local municipality referred to in the Schedule may by by-law provide for the election by general vote of one of its members to be named deputy mayor.</p>	<p><b>7.
