## CHAPTER Pr29

**An Act to revive  
Oaktown Property Management Limited**

*Assented to June 23, 1994*

Preamble

Franz Hoffmann, Gert Heynemann, Reinhold Wangler, Siegwart Spranger, Marianne Lanzl-Koch and Hans von Monteton have applied for special legislation to revive Oaktown Property Management Limited. The applicants represent that they are directors and shareholders of the ongoing organization carried on in the name of the corporation. The applicants represent that they were all of the directors and shareholders of the corporation when it was dissolved. The corporation was dissolved under the *Business Corporations Act, 1982* on July 27, 1987 for default in complying with the *Corporations Tax Act*. The applicants represent that they were not aware of the dissolution until more than two years after it occurred.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

**1. Oaktown Property Management Limited** Corporation revived  
is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

**2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.** Commencement

**3. The short title of this Act is the *Oaktown Property Management Limited Act, 1994*.** Short title
