CHAPTER Pr30

**An Act respecting the
Town of Picton**

Assented to June 23, 1994

Preamble

The Corporation of the Town of Picton has applied for special legislation to allow its council to pass a by-law reducing the number of members on council without receiving the assent of the electors.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

Assent of electors not required

1. (1) The council of The Corporation of the Town of Picton may pass a by-law under subsection 31 (3) of the *Municipal Act* reducing the number of councillors to be elected by

general vote from six councillors to four without receiving the assent of the municipal electors.

(2) A by-law passed under section 1 and a by-law repealing it shall, in an election year, be passed not later than 30 days before the last day for posting notices of the offices for which persons may be nominated in accordance with the *Municipal Elections Act*.

Timing

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Commencement

3. The short title of this Act is the *Town of Picton Act, 1994*.
