CHAPTER Pr33

**An Act respecting the
Town of Orangeville**

Assented to June 23, 1994

Preamble	<p>The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville has applied for special legislation providing that its council be composed in accordance with the provisions of the <i>Municipal Act</i>.</p> <p>It is appropriate to grant the application.</p> <p>Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:</p>	<p><i>Act</i>, the council of the Corporation shall be composed of a mayor, a reeve and a deputy reeve and six councillors to be elected by general vote.</p> <p>4. No action taken, resolution made or by-law passed by a council of the Corporation before this Act comes into force is invalid by virtue only that the council may not have been properly constituted.</p>	<p>Actions, resolutions and by-laws of councils not invalid</p>
Definition	<p>1. In this Act, "Corporation" means The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville.</p>	<p>5. Section 7 of <i>An Act to Incorporate the Town of Orangeville and to define the limits thereof, 1873</i>, being chapter 55, is repealed.</p>	<p>Repeal</p>
Composition of council	<p>2. The composition of the council of the Corporation shall be as provided in the <i>Municipal Act</i>.</p>	<p>6. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.</p>	<p>Commencement</p>
