CHAPTER Pr33

An Act respecting the **Town of Orangeville**

Assented to June 23, 1994

Preamble

The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville has applied for special legislation providing that its council be composed in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

Definition

1. In this Act, "Corporation" means The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville.

Composition of council

2. The composition of the council of the Corporation shall be as provided in the Municipal Act.

Transition

3. For the purposes of the regular election to be held in 1994 under the Municipal Elections Act, the council of the Corporation shall be composed of a mayor, a reeve and a deputy reeve and six councillors to be elected by general vote.

4. No action taken, resolution made or by- Actions, law passed by a council of the Corporation resolutions and by-laws before this Act comes into force is invalid by of councils virtue only that the council may not have been not invalid properly constituted.

- 5. Section 7 of An Act to Incorporate the Repeal Town of Orangeville and to define the limits thereof, 1873, being chapter 55, is repealed.
- 6. This Act comes into force on the day it Commencereceives Royal Assent.
- 7. The short title of this Act is the Town of Short title Orangeville Act, 1994.
