CHAPTER Pr38

An Act respecting the Town of Dresden

Assented to June 23, 1994

Preamble	<p>The Corporation of the Town of Dresden has applied for special legislation in respect of the matters set out in this Act.</p> <p>It is appropriate to grant the application.</p> <p>Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:</p>	<p>the number of councillors to be elected by general vote from six to four without having received the assent of the electors.</p> <p>(2) A by-law passed under this section and a by-law repealing it shall be passed not later than 30 days before the last day for posting notice of the offices for which persons may be nominated in accordance with the <i>Municipal Elections Act</i>.</p>	Timing

(1) Despite subsection 31 (5) of the <i>Municipal Act</i>, the council of The Corporation of the Town of Dresden may pass a by-law under subsection 31 (3) of that Act reducing</p>	<p>2.
