**An Act respecting the  
Township of East Luther and the Village of Grand Valley**

*Assented to December 9, 1994*

Preamble	<p>The Corporation of the Township of East Luther and The Corporation of the Village of Grand Valley represent that they have petitioned the Lieutenant Governor in Council to amalgamate them into one municipality. They have applied for special legislation concerning the supply of electrical power to residents of the amalgamated municipality.</p> <p>It is appropriate to grant the application.</p> <p>Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:</p>	<p>sion of the amalgamated municipality is the area of the former Village of Grand Valley.</p> <p>4. Despite the <i>Public Utilities Act</i>, Ontario Hydro may continue to supply electrical power to those customers and areas within the amalgamated municipality that were formerly in the Township of East Luther.</p> <p>5. Ontario Hydro shall be deemed to have given approval under clause 83 (1) (a) of the <i>Power Corporation Act</i> to the continuation of the electrical power service area described in section 3 consisting of the former Village of Grand Valley.</p>	<p>Continuation of supply</p> <p>Deemed approval</p>
