CHAPTER Pr48

An Act to revive **Durham Regional Police Association Inc.**

Assented to December 9, 1994

Preamble

Terry Ryan has applied for special legislation to revive Durham Regional Police Association Inc. The applicant represents that he is the president of the ongoing organization carried on in the name of the corporation. The corporation was dissolved under the Corporations Act on January 27, 1987 for default in complying with the Corporations Information Act. The applicant represents that this default was inadvertent, that he was not aware of the dissolution until seven years after it had occurred and that activity has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as fol-

- 1. The Durham Regional Police Associ- Corporation ation Inc. is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.
- 2. This Act comes into force on the day it Commencereceives Royal Assent.
- 3. The short title of this Act is the Durham Short title Regional Police Association Inc. Act, 1994.
