CHAPTER Pr51

**An Act respecting the
Sarnia Community Foundation**

Assented to December 9, 1994

Preamble	<p>The board of directors of the Sarnia Community Foundation has applied for special legislation to replace the current board of directors, to increase the number of directors and amend their terms of office and to amend the composition of the nomination committee. The applicant represents that the name of the Foundation was changed by supplementary letters patent dated September 1, 1994 from The City of Sarnia Foundation to the Sarnia Community Foundation.</p> <p>It is appropriate to grant the application.</p> <p>Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:</p> <p>1. Section 3 of the <i>City of Sarnia Foundation Act, 1982</i> is repealed and the following substituted:</p>	<p>(5) A member of the Board who has served for six consecutive years is not eligible for reappointment until one year after he or she ceases to hold office.</p> <p>(6) When a member of the Board ceases to hold office before his or her term expires, the person appointed by the nominating committee to fill the vacancy holds office until the expiry of the term of the original member.</p> <p>(7) Members of the Board shall serve without remuneration.</p> <p>3.2 (1) The members of the Board who hold office immediately before the coming into force of this section cease to hold office on the day this section comes into force.</p> <p>(2) Despite subsections 3.1 (1) and (2), on the day this section comes into force the following persons are appointed as members of the Board for the following terms of office:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Harold Hall, William Graham, James Wales and Joan Link, for a term expiring on December 31, 1995. 2. Gordon Catterson, Madeline Mahon, John Rozema and Andrew MacLaren, for a term expiring on December 31, 1996. 3. Heather Rath, David Brown, Christopher Curran and Nan Punnett, for a term expiring on December 31, 1997. <p>2. Paragraph 2 of subsection 4 (1) of the Act is repealed.</p> <p>3. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.</p> <p>4. The short title of this Act is the <i>Sarnia Community Foundation Act, 1994</i>.</p>	<p>Same</p> <p>Replacement</p> <p>No remuneration</p> <p>Current Board dissolved</p> <p>Transitional Board</p>
Members of the Foundation	<p>3. The Foundation is composed of the members of its board of directors, referred to in this Act as the Board.</p>		
Board	<p>3.1 (1) The Board shall be composed of 12 members appointed by the nominating committee or such other number of members appointed by the nominating committee as may be determined by a special resolution of the members.</p>		
Term of office	<p>(2) The term of office of members of the Board shall be as determined by the Board, but shall not exceed three years.</p>		
Rotation	<p>(3) The term of office of at least four members of the Board must expire each year.</p>		
Reappointment	<p>(4) A member of the Board may be reappointed immediately after his or her term of office expires, provided that no member shall serve for more than six consecutive years.</p>		<p>Commencement</p> <p>Short title</p>
