#### CHAPTER Pr55

## An Act to revive **Parkway Delicatessen Limited**

Assented to December 9, 1994

Preamble

Felix and Margaret Csenar have applied for special legislation to revive Parkway Delicatessen Limited. The applicants represent that they are directors of the ongoing organization carried on in the name of the corporation. The corporation was dissolved under the Business Corporations Act on November 14, 1988 for default in complying with the Corporations Tax Act. The applicants represent that this default was inadvertent, that they were not aware of the dissolution until more than five years after it occurred and that business has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1. The Parkway Delicatessen Limited is re- Corporation vived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as of the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved.

- 2. This Act comes into force on the day it Commencement receives Royal Assent.
- 3. The short title of this Act is the Parkway Short title Delicatessen Limited Act, 1994.
