An Act to amend The Planning Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 29 of *The Planning Act*, being chapter 349 of the Revised s. 29, Statutes of Ontario, 1970, as amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1971, chapter 2, section 1, 1972, chapter 118, section 3, 1973, chapter 168, section 6, 1974, chapter 53, section 4, 1976, chapter 38, section 2 and 1978, chapter 93, section 2, is further amended by adding thereto the following subsections:
 - (5g) No order made under *The Partition Act* for the partition Order made under of land shall have any effect in law unless,

 c. 338
 - (a) irrespective of the order, each part of the land described in the order could be conveyed without contravening this section; or
 - (b) a consent is given to the order.
 - (5h) This section does not apply to an agreement entered into Exception under section 2 of *The Drainage Act*, 1975.
- **2.** Section 33a of the said Act, as enacted by the Statutes of Ontario, s. 33a. 1978, chapter 93, section 5, is repealed.
- **3.**—(1) Subsection 3 of section 42 of the said Act is repealed and the s. 42 (3). re-enacted following substituted therefor:
 - (3) In addition to its powers under subsections 1 and 2 and Power of committee subject to section 30, the committee, upon the application of, to give
 - (a) the owner of any land or any person authorized in writing by such owner; or
 - (b) any person interested in any part of land that is affected by an order made under *The Partition Act*, as men-R.S.O. 1970. tioned in subsection 5g of section 29,

may, notwithstanding any other Act, give a consent as mentioned in section 29, provided that the committee is satisfied that a plan of subdivision under section 33 of the land described in the application is not necessary for the proper and orderly development of the municipality.

s. 42 (6), amended (2) Subsection 6 of the said section 42, as amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1971, chapter 2, section 5, is further amended by striking out "\$50" in the fourth line as inserted by the 1971 amendment and inserting in lieu thereof "\$100".

s. 42 (16), amended (3) Subsection 16 of the said section 42 is amended by adding at the end thereof "and there is no right to file a petition under section 94 of *The Ontario Municipal Board Act* in respect of the matter".

Commencement 4. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.
