(Chapter 24)

An Act to amend The County Courts Act

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1.—(1) Clause a of subsection 1 of section 14 of *The County Courts* s. 14 (1) (a). Act, being chapter 94 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by striking out "\$7,500" in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".
 - (2) Clause *b* of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by s. 14 (1) (*b*). striking out "\$7,500" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".
 - (3) Clause c of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by $\frac{s. 14 \text{ (1) } (c)}{amended}$ striking out "\$7,500" in the second line and in the fourth line and inserting in lieu thereof in each instance "\$15,000".
 - (4) Clause d of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by $\frac{s. 14 \text{ (1) } (d)}{\text{amended}}$ striking out "\$7,500" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".
 - (5) Clause *e* of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by ^{s. 14} (1) (*e*). striking out "\$7,500" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".
 - (6) Clause f of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by $^{\rm s.~14~(1)}_{\rm amended}$ striking out "\$7,500" in the fifth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".
 - (7) Clause *g* of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by s. 14 (1) (g). striking out "\$50,000" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$100,000".
 - (8) Clause *h* of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by ^{s. 14 (1) (h)}, striking out "\$7,500" in the fourth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000" and by striking out "\$50,000" in the fifth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$200,000".

APPENDIX

s. 14 (1) (*i*), amended

(9) Clause *i* of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by striking out "\$7,500" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".

s. 14 (1) (*j*), amended

(10) Clause j of subsection 1 of the said section 14 is amended by striking out "\$7,500" in the fourth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$15,000".

s. 14 (2), amended (11) Subsection 2 of the said section 14 is amended by striking out "\$50,000" in the eighth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$100,000" and by striking out "\$50,000" in the ninth line and inserting in lieu thereof "\$200,000".

Application of section

(12) This section does not apply to actions commenced before this section comes into force.

Commencement This Act comes into force on a day to be named by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor.

Short title

3. The short title of this Act is The County Courts Amendment Act, 1981.
