The Vicious Dogs Act

1. Where a dog is alleged to have bitten any person, the owner Dog biting of the dog may be summoned to appear before a provincial judge person to show cause why the dog should not be destroyed and, if from the evidence produced it appears that the dog has bitten any person, the judge may make an order that the dog be destroyed.
