TIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the H IS MAJESTT, by and when the determined the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:-

1. Champertors be they that move pleas and suits, or cause to Definition be moved, either by their own procurement, or by others, and sue of Chamthem at their proper costs, for to have part of the land in variance. or part of the gains. 33 Edw. I.

2. All champertous agreements are forbidden, and invalid, Champertous agree-(Added in the Revision of 1897.) ments void.
