CHAPTER 168

The Guarantee Companies Securities Act

- 1. In this Act, "guarantee company" means a corporation Interpreapproved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council and empowered to grant guarantees, bonds, policies or contracts for the integrity and fidelity of employed persons, or in respect of any legal proceedings or for other like purposes. R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 1.
- 2. Where a judge, functionary, officer or person is en-Bonds of guarantee titled or required to take security by bond with sureties, he company may in lieu thereof take the bond, policy or guarantee contaken by tract of a guarantee company of the like nature and effect. others R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 2.
- 3. Where a person is required to give security by bond Persons may give bond of with sureties, he may in lieu thereof furnish the bond, policy guarantee or guarantee contract of a guarantee company of the like nature and effect. R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 3.
- 4. The guarantee company shall not be bound or required not required to justify. R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 4.
- 5. The bond, policy or guarantee contract of a guarantee Bond of company company may be taken instead of or in substitution for any may be existing security if the judge, functionary, officer or person for other bonds mentioned in section 2 so directs. R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 5.
- 6. The interim receipt of a guarantee company may be Interim accepted in lieu of a bond, policy or guarantee contract, but lieu of bond the latter shall be furnished within one month. R.S.O. 1950, c. 162, s. 6.
