## c Pr2 City of London Act, 1991

Ontario

This statute received Royal Assent during the part of the First Session of the Thirty-Fifth Legislature which was held in 1991, before the *Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990* came into force. The statute as reproduced here has been revised pursuant to the *Statutes Revision Act, 1989* to reflect the changes that resulted from the coming into force of the *Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990*. The Statutes as originally enacted are set out in Volume 1 of the *Statutes of Ontario, 1991*.

## An Act respecting the City of London

*Assented to April 4th, 1991*

Commission continued	<p>1.—(1) The London Transit Commission is continued as a body corporate with the powers, rights and privileges vested in it by any general or special Act except as modified by this section.</p>	<p>(9) A member of the commission is eligible for reappointment.</p>	Reappointment
Composition of commission	<p>(2) The commission shall consist of five members appointed by the council of the Corporation.</p>	<p>(10) Three members of the commission constitute a quorum.</p>	Quorum
Member of council on commission	<p>(3) Two or three members of the commission, as determined by the council on or before the 15th day of February in the first year of its term, shall be members of the council and shall hold office during their term of office on the council.</p>	<p>(11) The commission may pass by-laws for the government and control of its affairs, operations and undertakings.</p>	By-laws
Other members of commission	<p>(4) The members of the commission who are not members of the council shall be appointed for a staggered length of time so that the term of office of one such member shall expire on the 30th day of November each year, but no such members shall hold office beyond the term of the council that appointed them.</p>	<p>(12) The commission is the agent of the Corporation and shall operate, repair, control and manage the local transportation system of the municipality on behalf of the Corporation.</p>	Commission is agent of the Corporation
Staggered terms	<p>(5) For the purpose of maintaining staggered terms of office, the council shall, when acting under subsection (3), designate the term of office of the members of the commission in office on the 15th day of February who are not members of the council.</p>	<p>(13) The commission and the council shall consult regularly on local transportation system policy and on the general administration and affairs of the commission in relation to general municipal policy and the administration and affairs of the Corporation.</p>	Consultation
Qualifications	<p>(6) No person is eligible to be appointed or to hold office as a member of the commission unless that person is qualified to be elected or to hold office as a member of the council of the Corporation.</p>	<p>(14) If, despite the consultations, there emerges a difference of opinion between the commission and the council concerning the course of policy to be followed, the council may by resolution give to the commission a directive concerning the local transportation system policy of the commission in specific terms and applicable for a specified period, and the commission shall comply with the directive.</p>	Resolution of conflicts
Term of office	<p>(7) A member of the commission shall hold office until the member's successor is appointed.</p>	<p>(15) The commission shall, in each year on or before such day as council may prescribe, prepare in consultation with the administrative departments of the Corporation and submit to the council for its consideration and approval an estimate of all sums required during the year for the purposes of the commission.</p>	Estimates
Vacancies	<p>(8) If the office of a member of the commission becomes vacant, the council shall appoint a person to hold office for the</p>	<p>(16) The commission shall, in each year on or before such day as council may prescribe, make a report to the council upon the affairs of the commission and the local transportation system of the municipality.</p>	Annual report
