## c Pr3 Lauramar Holdings Limited Act, 1991

Ontario

This statute received Royal Assent during the part of the First Session of the Thirty-Fifth Legislature which was held in 1991, before the *Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990* came into force. The statute as reproduced here has been revised pursuant to the *Statutes Revision Act, 1989* to reflect the changes that resulted from the coming into force of the *Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1990*. The Statutes as originally enacted are set out in Volume 1 of the *Statutes of Ontario, 1991*.

## CHAPTER Pr3

**An Act to revive  
Lauramar Holdings Limited**

*Assented to June 13th, 1991*

Preamble

Joan Sguigna has applied for special legislation to revive Lauramar Holdings Limited. The applicant represents that she is the director of the ongoing organization carried on in the name of the corporation. The Minister of Consumer and Commercial Relations dissolved the corporation on the 22nd day of December, 1980 for default in complying with the *Corporations Tax Act*. The applicant represents that this default was inadvertent, that she was not aware of the dissolution until more than two years after it had occurred and that business has been carried on in the name of the corporation despite the dissolution.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Lauramar Holdings Limited is revived and is, subject to any rights acquired by any person after its dissolution, restored to its legal position, including all its property, rights, privileges and franchises and subject to all its liabilities, contracts, disabilities and debts, as at the date of its dissolution, in the same manner and to the same extent as if it had not been dissolved. Revival

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commencement

3. The short title of this Act is the *Lauramar Holdings Limited Act, 1991*. Short title
