CHAPTER 17

An Act to amend The Evidence Act

Assented to April 14th, 1976

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. *The Evidence Act*, being chapter 151 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by adding thereto the following section:

47a. An affidavit or declaration is not inadmissible or unusable in evidence in an action for the reason only that it is made before the solicitor of a party to the action or before the partner, associate, clerk or agent of such solicitor. s. 47a, enacted
Affidavit sworn by solicitor for a party
2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commencement
3. This Act may be cited as *The Evidence Amendment Act, 1976*. Short title
