## CHAPTER 19

### An Act to amend The Public Authorities Protection Act

*Assented to April 14th, 1976*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1.—(1) Section 11 of *The Public Authorities Protection Act*, <sup>s. 11, amended</sup> being chapter 374 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by striking out “act, neglect or default complained of” in the sixth and seventh lines and inserting in lieu thereof “cause of action arose”.
- (2) The said section 11 is further amended by adding <sup>s. 11, amended</sup> thereto the following subsection:
  - (2) Subsection 1 does not apply to an action, prosecution <sup>Application of subs. 1</sup> or proceeding against,
    - (a) a sheriff for an act, neglect or default in certifying as to a writ of execution that binds land; or
    - (b) a land registrar for an act, neglect or default in connection with his duties under *The Registry Act* <sup>R.S.O. 1970, cc. 409, 234</sup> and *The Land Titles Act*.
2. Section 1 applies in respect of causes of action arising before <sup>Application of s. 1</sup> or after this Act comes into force.
3. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. <sup>Commencement</sup>
4. This Act may be cited as *The Public Authorities Protection Amendment Act, 1976*. <sup>Short title</sup>
