## CHAPTER 230.

## The Nurses' Registration Act.

1. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be pre-<sup>Training</sup>scribed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council for the pur-<sup>schools and</sup>poses of this Act,—<sup>register.</sup>

(a) A training school for nurses may be established, maintained and conducted in any hospital, sanitarium, sanatorium or university;

(b) A graduate of such training school, upon the payment of the fees prescribed by the regulations, shall be entitled to registration in a register kept for that purpose under the direction of the Minister of Health and a person while so registered may be designated "Registered Nurse." R.S.O. 1927, c. 360, s. 1; 1929, c. 87, s. 2; 1933, c. 54, s. 2.

2. Unless so registered no person shall use the title "Registered Nurse," either alone or in combination with any word or words or any name, title or description implying that he or she was registered under this Act, and any person contravening the provisions of this section shall incur a penalty not exceeding \$100, which shall be recoverable under *The Summary Convictions Act*. 3. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, from time to time, make rules and regulations for the carrying out of the provisions of this Act, and appoint officers to advise and assist in the administration of this Act and may prescribe their duties and powers and the period for which they shall continue in office.
