CHAPTER 250.

The Provincial Auctioneers' License Act.

Provincial
license.

1.—(1) The Minister of Agriculture may grant to any person, who in his opinion possesses special qualifications, a license to sell pure-bred live stock only, by public auction in Ontario.

Fee.

(2) Any person who resides in Ontario shall pay a fee of \$50, and any person who does not reside in Ontario shall pay a fee of \$100 for such license. R.S.O. 1927, c. 217, s. 1 (1, 2).

Term of
license.

2. The license or any renewal thereof shall remain in force only during the current calendar year of issue. R.S.O. 1927, c. 217, s. 2.

Municipal
license not
required.

3. A person holding a license under this Act shall not be required to take out an auctioneer's license in any municipality for the sale of pure-bred live stock. R.S.O. 1927, c. 217, s. 3.

Revocation
of license.

4. The Minister may revoke the license at any time for any cause appearing to him sufficient. R.S.O. 1927, c. 217, s. 4.
