## CHAPTER 106

**An Act to amend The Police Act***Assented to December 10th, 1974*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. *The Police Act*, being chapter 351 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by adding thereto the following section: s. 47a,  
enacted

47a. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may, out of moneys appropriated therefor by the Legislature, grant pecuniary aid or other assistance for the benefit of the surviving spouses and children of members of the Ontario Provincial Police Force who are killed or die from injuries received or from illness contracted in the discharge of their duties. Aid to  
dependants

2. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commence-  
ment
3. This Act may be cited as *The Police Amendment Act, 1974*. Short title
