## An Act to amend The County of Oxford Act, 1974

Assented to February 6th, 1975

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1.—(1) Section 1.34 of *The County of Oxford Act, 1974*, being <sup>s. 134</sup>, chapter 57, as amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1974, chapter 118, section 6, is further amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

(2d) The trustees of the Police Village of Burgessville as <sup>Idem</sup> it existed on the 31st day of December, 1974, shall, until such date as the Minister may by order designate, be deemed to be a commission established under Part III of *The Public* R.S.O. 1970. *Utilities Act*, for the Police Village of Burgessville Hydro-Electric System, to be known as The Hydro-Electric Commission of Burgessville, which shall be deemed to be a local board of the area municipality of the Township of Norwich, and all rights and obligations of the Police Village of Burgessville in relation to the Police Village of Burgessville Hydro-Electric System become the rights and obligations of The Hydro-Electric Commission of Burgessville.

(2e) The trustees of the Police Village of Otterville as it Idem existed on the 31st day of December, 1974, shall, until such date as the Minister may by order designate, be deemed to be a commission established under Part III of *The Public Utilities Act*, for the Police Village of Otterville Hydro-Electric System, to be known as The Hydro-Electric Commission of Otterville, which shall be deemed to be a local board of the area municipality of the Township of Norwich, and all rights and obligations of the Police Village of Otterville in relation to the Police Village of Otterville Hydro-Electric System become the rights and obligations of The Hydro-Electric Commission of Otterville.

(2f) The trustees of the Police Village of Thamesford as it <sup>Idem</sup> existed on the 31st day of December, 1974, shall, until such

R.S.O. 1970, c. 390 date as the Minister may by order designate, be deemed to be a commission established under Part III of *The Public Utilities Act*, for the Police Village of Thamesford Hydro-Electric System, to be known as The Hydro-Electric Commission of Thamesford, which shall be deemed to be a local board of the area municipality of the Township of Zorra, and all rights and obligations of the Police Village of Thamesford in relation to the Police Village of Thamesford Hydro-Electric System become the rights and obligations of The Hydro-Electric Commission of Thamesford.

s. 134 (3), amended (2) Subsection 3 of the said section 134, as amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1974, chapter 118, section 6, is further amended by striking out "and 2c" in the said amendment of 1974 and inserting in lieu thereof "2c, 2d, 2e and 2f".

Short title

3. This Act may be cited as The County of Oxford Amendment Act, 1974 (No. 2).

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 31st

day of December, 1974.
