CHAPTER 185

The Interprovincial Drainage Act

1. Wherever for the purpose of securing better drainage it Extending is deemed necessary or expedient to extend drainage works provincial from Ontario into or through lands in an adjoining province, drainage or to extend a drainage work from an adjoining province, into or through lands in Ontario, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may authorize the Minister of Public Works to enter into an agreement with a designated officer of the adjoining province as to the proportion of the cost of the work in the adjoining province to be borne and paid by Ontario and as to the proportion of the cost of the work in Ontario to be borne and paid by the adjoining province. R.S.O. 1937, c. 58, s. 1.

2. Where a drain extends from an adjoining province into Extension of and through lands in Ontario the Minister of Public Works $\frac{drain}{drain}$ from adjoining may order the municipality into which the drain extends to province. provide for the construction of the necessary drainage work and thereupon all the provisions of *The Municipal Drainage* Rev. Stat., *Act* shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to such drain and the con-^{c. 246}. tribution to the work from the other province shall be paid to such municipality on the proper completion of the work. R.S.O. 1937, c. 58, s. 2.

3. Where a drain extends from Ontario into and through Apportionlands in an adjoining province, the Minister of Public Works ment of cost. may order the municipality in Ontario in which the lands affected by the drainage work are situate, to provide funds to pay for the proportion of the cost of the work in the adjoining province to be borne and paid by Ontario, and thereupon all the provisions of *The Municipal Drainage Act* shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to such drain. R.S.O. 1937, c. 58, s. 3.
