CHAPTER 144

**An Act to amend
The District Welfare Administration
Boards Act**

*Assented to December 4th, 1973
Session Prorogued March 5th, 1974*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Clause *e* of section 1 of *The District Welfare Administration Boards Act*, being chapter 132 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by striking out "Social and Family Services" in the first and second lines and inserting in lieu thereof "Community and Social Services". s. 1 (e),

- 2.—(1) Subsection 4 of section 6 of the said Act is amended by inserting after "to" in the first line "subsections 10 and 10a and to". s. 6 (4),

- (2) The said section 6, as amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1972, chapter 1, section 21, is further amended by adding thereto the following subsection: s. 6,
amended

(10a) Where any municipality in the district did not exist in the immediately preceding year, the amount that the board estimates will be required from that municipality for the current year shall be in proportion to the amount, estimated by the board, of the assessment of the municipality for the current year, and the board shall in that case reapportion the amount and make the necessary adjustments in accordance with the revised equalized assessment of the municipality for the current year after such revision and equalization is completed. 3. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent. Commence-
