#### CHAPTER 145

### An Act to amend The Elderly Persons Centres Act

Assented to December 4th, 1973 Session Prorogued March 5th, 1974

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

- 1. Clause f of section 1 of The Elderly Persons Centres Act, amended being chapter 140 of the Revised Statutes of Ontario, 1970, is amended by striking out "Social and Family Services" in the first and second lines and inserting in lieu thereof "Community and Social Services".
- 2.—(1) Subsection 1 of section 2 of the said Act, as re-enacted amended by the Statutes of Ontario, 1971, chapter 50, section 35, is amended by striking out "Lieutenant Governor in Council" in the first line and inserting in lieu thereof "Minister".
  - (2) Subsection 2 of the said section 2 is amended by \$2(2) amended striking out "Lieutenant Governor in Council" in the first line and inserting in lieu thereof "Minister", by striking out "a building" in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof "all or any part of a building or buildings" and by inserting after "premises" in the fifth line "or part thereof, as the case may be".
  - (3) Subsection 3 of the said section 2, as amended by the s. 2 (3) Statutes of Ontario, 1972, chapter 158, section 2, is further amended by striking out "Licutenant Governor in Council" in the second and third lines and inserting in lieu thereof "Minister".
- 3. (1) Subsection 1 of section 8 of the said Act, as re-s.8(1), amended enacted by the Statutes of Ontario, 1971, chapter 50, section 35, is amended by striking out "by the Minister or revoked by the Lieutenant Governor in Council on the recommendation of the Minister" in the second. third and fourth lines and inserting in lieu thereof "or revoked by the Minister".

s. 8 (2).

(2) Subsection 2 of the said section 8 is amended by striking out "before recommending to the Lieutenant Governor in Council revocation of" in the third and fourth lines and inserting in lieu thereof "revoking".

s. B (5). amended (3) Subsection 5 of the said section 8 is amended by striking out "recommend revocation of" in the third line and inserting in lieu thereof "revoke".

s. 10 (a), repealed 4. Clause a of section 10 of the said Act is repealed.

Commence-

5. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

Short title

6. This Act may be cited as The Elderly Persons Centres Amendment Act, 1973.
