CHAPTER 28

An Act to amend The Industrial Safety Act, 1964

Assented to June 26th, 1970
Session Prorogued November 13th, 1970

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of *The Industrial Safety Act, 1964*, as amended by section 1 of *The Industrial Safety Amendment Act, 1968*, is further amended by relettering clause *a* as clause *aa* and by adding thereto the following clauses:

(a) "architect" means a person registered as a member of the Ontario Association of Architects or a person who is licensed to practise as an architect under *The Architects Act*;

(ma) "professional engineer" means a person who is a member of the Association of Professional Engineers of the Province of Ontario or who is licensed to practise as a professional engineer under *The Professional Engineers Act, 1968-69*.

2. Section 16 of *The Industrial Safety Act, 1964*, as amended by section 4 of *The Industrial Safety Amendment Act, 1968*, is further amended by adding thereto the following subsection:

(2a) Drawings and specifications of a building that is to be or is more than two storeys in height shall bear the signature and seal of a professional engineer or an architect.

3. Section 25 of *The Industrial Safety Act, 1964* is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

25. No person shall employ in an industrial establishment during school hours a person who is required under *The Schools Administration Act* to attend school.
