## CHAPTER 92

## An Act to amend The Judicature Act

*Assented to November 13th, 1970*  
*Session Prorogued November 13th, 1970*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

**1.** Subsection 1 of section 5 of *The Judicature Act*, as <sup>R.S.O. 1960,</sup> amended by section 1 of *The Judicature Amendment Act, 1970*, <sup>c. 197, s. 5,</sup> is further amended by striking out "thirty" in the amendment <sup>subs. 1,</sup> of 1970 and inserting in lieu thereof "thirty-one", so that the subsection shall read as follows:

(1) The High Court shall consist of a chief justice who <sup>High Court</sup> shall be the president thereof and who shall be called <sup>of Justice</sup> the Chief Justice of the High Court, and thirty-one other judges.

**2.** This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal <sup>Commence-</sup> Assent. <sup>ment</sup>

**3.** This Act may be cited as *The Judicature Amendment Act*, <sup>Short title</sup> 1970 (No. 3).
