CHAPTER 101

**An Act to amend
The Judges' Orders Enforcement Act**

*Assented to November 13th, 1970
Session Prorogued, November 13th, 1970*

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of *The Judges' Orders Enforcement Act* is amended by striking out "Court of Appeal" in the second line and in the seventh line and inserting in lieu thereof in each instance "Divisional Court", so that the section shall read as follows:

3. An appeal lies from an order made by a judge as *persona designata* to the Divisional Court, ^{Appeal}

(a) if the right of appeal is given by the statute under which the judge acted; or

(b) if no such right of appeal is given, then by leave of the judge who made the order or by leave of the Divisional Court.

2. This Act does not apply to applications or proceedings commenced before the day this Act comes into force. ^{Application}

3. This Act comes into force on a day to be named by the Lieutenant Governor by his proclamation. <sup>Commence-
ment</sup>

4. This Act may be cited as *The Judges' Orders Enforcement Amendment Act, 1970*. ^{Short title}
