CHAPTER 111.

The Judges' Orders Enforcement Act.

1.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Statute under which he acts where jurisdiction is given to a judge as *per-sona designata* his orders shall be entered in the same way as orders made by him in matters pending in the court of which he is a judge and may be enforced in the same way as judgments of the court. Enforcing orders of judge made under special statutory authority.

(2) All affidavits used upon any such application shall be filed with the clerk of the court as upon ordinary applications in a matter pending in the court. Filing of affidavits.

(3) The same fee shall be paid for such filings and upon any order made as in ordinary proceedings in the court. Fees. 1926, c. 26, s. 2.

2. Subject to the provisions of the Statute under which he acts upon any such application the judge shall have the same jurisdiction as to costs and otherwise as in matters in court under his ordinary jurisdiction. Jurisdiction as to costs, etc. 1926, c. 26, s. 3.

3.—(1) An appeal shall lie from any such order to the Appellate Division; Appeal.

(a) when the right of appeal is given by the Statute under which the judge acts, or;

(b) when no such right of appeal is given then by leave of the judge making the order or by leave of a judge of the Supreme Court.

(2) The decision of the Appellate Division shall be final. 1926, c. 26, s. 4.
