## CHAPTER 255.

## The Tree Planting Act.

1. An owner of land may with the consent of the owner of <sup>Trees on</sup> adjoining land, plant trees on the boundary between such <sup>boundary</sup> lands, and every tree so planted shall be the common property <sup>lines.</sup> of such owners. 1927, c. 69, s. 2.

2. Any person who ties or fastens any animal to or injures <sup>Penalty for</sup> or destroys any tree growing for the purposes of shade or <sup>injuring</sup> ornament upon a boundary line between lands, or who suffers <sup>trees on</sup> or permits any animal in his charge to injure or destroy or <sup>highways.</sup> who trims, cuts down or removes any such tree without the consent of the owners thereof, shall on summary conviction incur a penalty not exceeding \$25. 1927, c. 69, s. 3.
