CHAPTER 257.

An Act for the Protection of Bees.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:—

- short title. 1. This Act may be cited as *The Bee Protection Act*.

- Use of poison in spraying fruit trees in bloom prohibited. 2. No person in spraying or sprinkling fruit trees during the period within which such trees are in full bloom shall use any mixture containing Paris green or any other poisonous substance injurious to bees. 2 Geo. V. c. 72, s. 2.
- Penalties. 3. Any person contravening the provisions of this Act shall incur a penalty of not less than \$1 and not more than \$5 recoverable under *The Ontario Summary Convictions Act*.
